Landmark travel bonus announced for V Commonwealth Tenpin Bowling Championship

The Organising Committee of the V Commonwealth Tenpin Bowling Championship has just released details of a landmark arrangement with Malaysia Airlines and local travel agency, Roystar Network Bay, that alleviates the perennial hurdle faced by bowlers worldwide of travelling with heavyweight bowling equipment.

Teams flying to Kuala Lumpur on MAS from numerous international destinations are offered the significant benefit of an additional 30kgs baggage allowance – a total of 50kgs in all.

In partnership with the Ministry of Youth & Sports Malaysia, and additional support from Tourism Malaysia, Sunway Megalanes, the official hotels and other sponsors, the Organising Committee is well advanced with preparations to deliver a spectacular event for bowlers, officials and supporters from Commonwealth nations around the world. Teams from every continent have registered to participate in the tournament that will be staged from Saturday, 19 February to Sunday, 27 February 2011.

Background: *Following the inaugural Commonwealth Tenpin Bowling Championship held in Stirling, Scotland in 2002 an association of national Federations representing numerous Commonwealth countries was formed with the specific goal of staging biennial Commonwealth Championships that will ultimately meld into the official Commonwealth Games program. Since then, three further Championships have been staged in Paphos, Cyprus, Melbourne, Australia and Belfast, Northern Ireland.*
