CGF sanctions medals for V Commonwealth Tenpin Bowling Championship

Bowlers and teams participating in the V Commonwealth Tenpin Bowling Championship in Kuala Lumpur will compete for some of the sport's most highly coveted medals and trophy.

The Championship has been formally sanctioned by the Commonwealth Games Federation, and the impressive medals now being produced will incorporate the famous CGF 'bar' in a uniquely designed logo that has been approved by CGF officials.

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented for individual and mixed Singles, Doubles and Team events during the tournament that will run from 19-26 February. The biennial Championship is regarded as one of the highlights on the sport's international calendar.

The CTBF perpetual Triple Diamond Trophy, representing the international zones of the sport of bowling, will also be awarded to the highest scoring team overall.

Team England currently holds the Triple Diamond shield, following its outstanding performance at the previous Championship in Belfast. Inaugural winner of the Trophy, Australia, will be one of the many Commonwealth nations striving to win this prestigious trophy and the CGF sanctioned medals in Kuala Lumpur next month.
